Thank you to everyone – 112 members! -- who responded to our online survey. Your input and your volunteer offers – plus your comments at the October meeting and the AGM -- have helped the board to say yes, no, or maybe, to these suggestions:

YES: We are searching for food services, led by Chris Buchanan.

YES: We are contacting retirement and community groups, led by Allan Terplawy & Esther Oaks.

YES: We will plan new social events.

YES: We are proceeding with partnership matching, led by Adele Lewchuk.

YES: We are proceeding with ride-sharing, led by Ron Chalmers.

YES: We hope to begin advertising on social media.

But we need a volunteer who knows a bit about social media or is willing to learn. Please speak to Matthew or to any board member if you can help.

NO: We will not immediately raise card fees. While 70% of you supported an increase, we recently did raise membership fees. We may reconsider card fees next year.
